



Bright Start is the name for Islington's services for under-5s and their families

living in Islington and includes Start for Life and Family Hubs.

You can find services in children's centres, nurseries, health centres, community centres and libraries across Islington.

Bright Start services are delivered in the North, Central and South areas. If you live in Islington you can attend sessions

- Speech and language therapy

- Benefits advice
